1. The applicant will participate in the general school programme that gives St Bede's College its Catholic Special Character.
2. The undersigned undertakes, as a condition of enrolment and attendance at the school, to pay Attendance Dues as determined by the Proprietor from time to time and approved by the Minister of Education.
3. I / We understand that there are voluntary contributions payable for curricula and extra curricula activities and resources, Building Development and Special Character expenses plus the annual Diocesan contribution and E-learning contribution. I / We acknowledge responsibility for these.
4. The policies and rules as laid down by the Board of Trustees and the Board of Proprietors are observed and it is understood that in the case of boarders, the Board of Proprietors and Staff are in loco parentis during term time.
5. Enrolment is subject to the St Bede's College Enrolment Policy and availability and that the final decision on accepting a student for enrolment at St Bede's College is with the Rector.

Special Catholic Character

The Catholic Church considers itself called to follow the example of Jesus Christ. St Bede's College aims to provide an education which has, as its foundation, Gospel values.

The College endeavours to achieve this aim by:

- Teaching Religious Education according to the National Catholic Syllabus to all students of every level.
- An annual Retreat Day for all classes.
- Regular prayer times at assemblies and in class.
- At least one whole-school Eucharist celebration each term.
- Weekly Sunday Eucharist for the Boarding School.
- Weekly Benediction available for the whole school each Friday.
- Opportunity and preparation for the Sacraments of Initiation.
- Major fundraising events for charity.
- Christian Leadership programmes.
