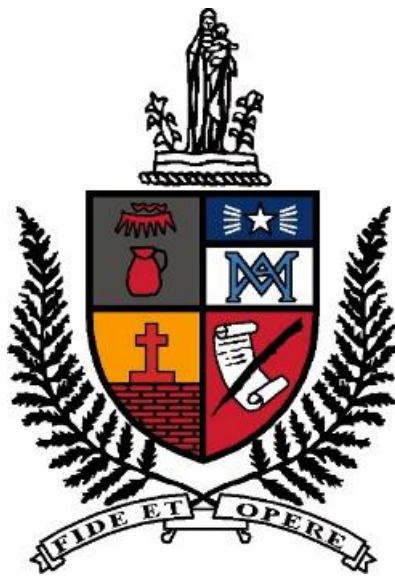

Rationale

5. To provide parents with clear guidelines on dress.
6. To create the mechanism for parents and students to engage with the Board of Trustees to propose and discuss changes to the uniform.
